Application: *So what?*

Watch out for any falsehood you believe related to...
Christ, your status with Christ, the church and your
identity in Christ

Questions to consider:

Point #1: Walk in Christ - From verse 7, what are the 4
ways we walk in Christ? What are some practical ways we
can be rooted in truth? Edified by one another? Showing
maturity in our faith? Overflowing with joyfulness?

Point #2: Watch Out: What are the four doctrinal areas Paul
warns the church to look out (2:8-15)? What are some
current philosophies or empty deceptions from mankind
and the enemy that are affecting the local church?

According to verse 9, who was Christ? According to verse
10, what is our status with Christ? According to verses
11-12, who/what is the church? According to verses 13-15,
what is our changed identity and how did it happen?
Is there any of the 4 areas that you aren't familiar with?
Which of them speaks to you dearest?
